

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JURUPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA, ADDING CHAPTER 1.35, COUNTY ORDINANCES ADOPTED, TO THE JURUPA VALLEY MUNICIPAL CODE ADOPTING ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE (INCLUDING LAND USE ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS) TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS CITY ORDINANCES UNTIL SUPERSEDED BY CITY ORDINANCES

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JURUPA VALLEY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 1.35, County Ordinances Adopted, is hereby added to the Jurupa Valley Municipal Code to read as follows:

“Chapter 1.35 County Ordinances Adopted

1.35.010 County Ordinances to Remain in Effect.

- A. Pursuant to the provisions of California Government Code Section 57376, all ordinances of the County of Riverside, including land use ordinances and the ordinance adopting the County General Plan, which have been applicable within the territory now incorporated as the City of Jurupa Valley, to the extent that they applied before incorporation, shall remain in full force and effect as ordinances of the City of Jurupa Valley.
- B. The resolutions, rules and regulations of the County of Riverside which have been applicable in the implementation of the aforesaid ordinances and State laws (including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act and regulations pertaining to traffic) to the extent that they applied before incorporation shall remain in full force and effect as resolutions, rules and regulations, respectively, of the City of Jurupa Valley.
- C. Each ordinance or resolution of the County of Riverside which remains in effect as set out in this Section shall remain in effect as a City ordinance until the Council adopts an ordinance or resolution superseding it. Any City ordinance enacted to supersede a County ordinance must specifically refer to the County ordinance and state an intention to supersede it. Ordinances 2011-01 through 2011-06, inclusive, of the City of Jurupa Valley are intended to supersede the Riverside County ordinances described in this section.

- D. Any fees adopted by the ordinances described in this section may be modified by a resolution of the City Council of the City of Jurupa Valley. The City Council of the City of Jurupa Valley shall have the authority to establish or modify fees by resolution of the City Council subject to the requirements and procedures of State law.

1.35.020 Substitution of References to City.


Certain County ordinances and resolutions referred to in Section 1.35.010 reflect the County's governmental structure and contain references to officials, titles, commissions and other designations which are not part of the structure of the City. In order to effectively administer such County ordinances and resolutions, the substitution of the appropriate City official, title or designation shall occur, including but not limited to those which follow:

- A. Whenever "Board of Supervisors" or "Board" is used in the County Code or relevant county ordinances or resolutions, it shall mean the Jurupa Valley City Council.
- B. Whenever "County" or "County of Riverside" is used in the County Code or relevant County ordinances, it shall mean the jurisdictional limits of the City of Jurupa Valley unless a different geographical or jurisdictional area is clearly indicated by the context.
- C. Whenever "unincorporated territory of the County of Riverside" issued in the County Code or relevant County ordinances, it shall mean the City of Jurupa Valley unless a different geographical area is clearly indicated by the context.
- D. Whenever "Planning Commission," "Board of Zoning Adjustment," "Board of Appeals," "Zoning Administrator or any similar reference to a County person or body is used, it shall mean-the Jurupa Valley Planning Commission or those agencies or officials acting as the agents of the City of Jurupa Valley."

Section 2. **Effect of Ordinance.** This Ordinance is intended to supersede any ordinance or resolution of the County of Riverside in conflict with the terms of this ordinance.




